

4th JULY REOPENING UPDATE

We have now worked our way through the guidelines that have been set out and implemented our risk assessment which will be constantly reviewed to reflect the ongoing changes that will be made to these guidelines as time passes, and have put measures in place so that our staff, customers and ourselves can feel safe during these times.

Hand sanitization station is available up on entry (use of this will be mandatory when entering the premises) for your safety and ours, please make use of this as many times as you wish whilst inside.

Regular extra cleaning of surfaces, touch points and toilets will be undertaken, sanitizer will be available in the toilets for you to use on handles, locks, taps and the flush for an extra piece of mind if you so wish.

In partnership with the extra cleaning wipes will be positioned around for you to use to guarantee to you a “first to touch”

Some things that will be a little different.

We are required to take contact details of everyone that enters, (nothing intrusive and no more information than we would take when booking a meal) to aid track and trace, which can be destroyed after 21 days.

To enable a 1m social distance we have removed some tables and seating and therefore ask customers not to move any of the furniture as it has been arranged for your safety.

The bar stools have also been removed as sitting or standing at the bar to drink isn't permitted, customers are encouraged to take a seat and we will bring your order to you, we will therefore have designated tables that are kept free of diners for you to sit at whilst having a drink.

We are also limited to the number of people that are allowed on the premises so please do not take offence if we if you cannot serve you, whilst there are tables outside please keep in mind that if the weather turns as it often does we may be unable to let you inside if we are at our permitted capacity. We are currently working on a solution to this.

The menu has been reduced so that we can operate with fewer staff as per guidelines to reduce people contact. Our menu has also been reprinted doing away with paper copies and is now in a format that can be effectively cleaned.

We will be opening on the 4th at midday but for this weekend we will only be serving drink and our takeaway food service.

Then from Friday 10th we will start serving food fully.

We will be operating on limited opening times for July, Friday, Sat and Sunday only with a view to extend in August.

Food will be served 12-2pm and then 5-9pm (8pm on a Sunday) and the bar will be open all day.

We will still be offering our take away service throughout and still be using the option to pay over the phone.

Finally we would like to thank all those that have used our take away service and supported us over the last couple of months and we are looking forward to seeing everyone soon.
